## Boston School Committee Deadline Extended

*Applications are now due on Monday, December 6*

The Boston School Committee Nominating Panel is still accepting applications for two open seats on the seven-member School Committee. The expression of interest by Boston residents in serving the City by applying for a School Committee position may also be used by the Menino Administration to identify citizens for other appointed positions.

Boston residents who are interested in playing a leadership role in improving public education in Boston can still apply to become a member of the Boston School Committee. Committee members serve staggered four-year terms. The terms of Rev. Gregory G. Groover, Sr. and Alfreda J. Harris will expire in January 2011. Both members will re-apply for their current seats.

At least three names and no more than five names must be chosen by the Panel for each open position to be presented to Mayor Menino. The Mayor will then select the new

members whose terms will start on Monday, January 3, 2011.

The School Committee Nominating Panel is composed of 13 members representing parents, teachers, principals, higher education and business leaders. The Panel seeks candidates who represent the diversity of the Boston Public Schools and who have leadership experience in areas such as business, youth work, and education.
