



Boston Public Schools:

- On March 30, the City announced a [partnership between the Boston Housing Authority \(BHA\) and Boston Public Schools \(BPS\)](#) to provide housing support for up to 1,000 families with students in Boston schools who are at risk of displacement or are homelessness. The support will come in the form of vouchers that will provide significant subsidy for families seeking housing options in the private market.
- All schools are closed until at least May 4. BPS is continuing to offer [free breakfast and lunch](#) to children at a number of locations city-wide. For students without reliable access to computers, [BPS is providing Chromebooks](#) to support learning from home. - The [Boston School Committee](#) is holding all meetings virtually until further notice. The Committee's most recent meeting was held virtually on Wednesday, March 25 and the next meeting is scheduled for April 15.
