

Opportunity to Serve on the Boston School Committee

Qualified Candidates Needed: Deadline November 7th

Interested in shaping the future of the Boston Public Schools? Consider applying to join the Boston School Committee, the governing body of Boston Public Schools. Two full-term seats are available as both Dr. Stephen Alkins' and Brandon Cardet-Hernandez's terms expire at the end of this year. Additionally, because current School Committee Vice-Chair Michael O'Neill will be stepping down at the end of December to serve as the executive director of the Boston Private Industry Council, applications are being sought for the remainder of his term, which expires on January 2nd, 2029. Mr. O'Neill has served on the committee since first appointed by Mayor Menino in 2008 and was Chair from 2013 to 2017. Role of the Boston School Committee - The Boston School Committee plays a crucial role in making decisions that impact the direction and quality of K-12 public education in Boston. It works to create an inclusive and effective educational system that addresses the needs of students, families, and educators. Some of the essential functions of the School Committee include setting the district's objectives, approving and overseeing the implementation of the Boston Public Schools \$1.58B [annual budget](#), allocating resources effectively to benefit students and improve learning environments, and selecting and evaluating the Superintendent. With Boston Public Schools constituting Boston's largest single expenditure at 32.7% of the FY26 budget, maintaining strong fiscal oversight over the BPS budget is critical to the City's overall fiscal health.

Additionally, the School Committee initiates, approves and ratifies BPS collective bargaining agreements. The School Committee approved a renewed [three-year contract](#) with the Boston Teachers Union earlier this year that will have [significant cost and policy implications](#) for the City and will remain in effect until August 31, 2027. Requirements & Process – The School Committee is composed of seven voting members [appointed](#) by the Mayor and one non-voting student representative. Applicants must be Boston residents and submit the [application form](#) with basic information and responses to a series of questions. The School Committee Nominating Panel will vet and publicly interview applicants via Zoom on November 18-20 from 5:00-8:00pm. The Nominating Panel consists of [13 members](#) from diverse backgrounds, including parents, business leaders, and educators. Following the interview process the panel will present three to five candidates for each vacancy to the Mayor, who will select two individuals to serve on the School Committee for four-year terms expiring January 7th, 2030, and one individual to serve the remainder of the term expiring on January 2, 2029.
